

Surrey Closed 2023 Day 2

The over 60's Men's groups saw 2nd seed and over 60's winner for the last 3 seasons Steve Davis get through his group in second place by the slimmest of margins on count back as he lost to Percy Collino and Joe Leone only Jonathan Chernett's win over Joe Leone saved Steve. The semi-finals saw Daniel Heo good run come to an end as he was beaten by Adam Laws. Goran Maric beat Percy Collino 3-2 (7-11, 12-10, 11-9, 7-11, 11-8) in the other semi-final. In the final Adam beat Goran 3 straight taking back the trophy he lost last year due to illness.
