At the PTT Czech Open in Ostrava Arron McKibbin took the Silver medal in the Men's Class 8 event.

Ollie Maric-Murray won the under-13's Greenhouse 4 star at Crest Academy.

Max Flint won a Silver Medal at the PTT Waterside tournament losing the final to the narrowest of margins to Buckinghamshire's Jaiden Caldeira 10-12, 11-9, 11-5, 10-12, 11-13.

Darius Knight won the Hunts 2 star Open and was up against Niall Camoron in the final.

Cain Fagan was runner-up of the Men's Band 5 and the Men's Band 6 events at the Crawley Grand Prix.

Surrey's under-13 Closed Tournament had a large entry. It was also the first tournament that a few of the players had ever played in. At the quarter-final stage there were no surprises but a few tight matches as Francesco Bonato beat Jacob Archer 11-8, 8-11, 11-9, 11-6 and Ojasvii beat Daniel Clark 8-11, 12-10, 11-9, 11-6. In the semi-finals the top 2 seeds both won 3-0 with Ollie Maric-Murray beating Ojasvii Borah and Francesco beating Adam Palmer. In the final the No.1 seed Ollie didn't have it all his own way as he lost the third game 11-5. However he did triumph overall in a great match. The under-13 girls was a round robin with Emily Cheung winning in a tight match 11-3, 6-11, 12-10 11-9 against under 12 Caron Charles. The Consolation event saw Daniyal Palmer beat Lucas Gabb in the final. All in all a great tournament run by Jane Barella.
