

Lon Moir Obituary (Feb 19<sup>th</sup> 1924 – 30<sup>th</sup> Jan 2018).



Lon started playing in 1953 – then moving to Selsdon he formed the Monks Hill TT Club in 1974 at the Sports Centre.

Season 1974-75 saw the Club entering both the Croydon Business Houses and Croydon and District Leagues. There were a number of teams in the leagues until they both stopped in the 1990 -91 season. The Croydon League started 1991-92.

Teams also played in the Bromley League late 80's early 90's.

Lon then became Chair of the Croydon League from 1996-97 until 2007-08. He took over from Jim Norris and finally gave up the Monks Hill club in 2009-10 after some 45 years.

A committee member of the District League from 1981-82 until 1990-91 - running a division for some of those seasons.

He was instrumental in achieving Premier Club status for Monks Hill due to the coaching set up within the club. (ETTA days).

His club was involved in the Croydon-Arnheim link for 2 or 3 years.

With Dave Fish he undertook coaching in local schools and started a local schools league.

Lon certainly did his bit for Monks Hill and Croydon Table Tennis. Many thanks!
