For Avon it was veterans Martin Gunn and Michelle Reeves who led the way. Jake Mitchell put Surrey on the scoreboard with a win over Dave Reeves at 11-8 in the 5th. John Lee levelled the match at 2-2 with a 3-straight win against Anthony Kent. After that it was downhill for Surrey as Avon rattled off the next 6 although Isabelle Joubaily was perhaps a little unfortunate to lose at 9 in the 5th against Emily Standing

Against Cornwall, Surrey took a 4-1 lead which included a good win for John Lee over Darren Reed. However the tide turned for Surrey at 5-2 up as 3 consecutive sets were lost in the 5th game. Darren Reed beat Andreas Pusch 13-15, 8-11, 11-9, 14-12, 13-11 and Rachel Trevorrow beat Isabelle Joubaily 12-10 in the 5th. Carl Baldry clinched the draw for Cornwall beating John Lee 7 in the 5th.

Surrey's sole win of the weekend . came against Devon II. Surrey took a 5-1 lead in this match although 3 of those sets were decided in the 5th game. Both Isabelle Joubaily and Fei Fei Pei did well to beat Naomi Jackson but Kelsey Le Maistre beat Fei Fei.

Dorset were flexing their muscles with the inclusion of England No 16 Matt Ware. With Hugo Pang and Gina Rieck in the team they were a bit too hot to handle for Surrey. Andreas Pusch lost in 3 to Hugo but this included one game decided at 22-24 ! John Lee did well to pinch an end from Matt Ware as did Isabelle against Gina. Surrey took a little consolation in Fei Fei beating Lily Cherry while John Lee beat Finn Morgan-Bayliss.

Surrey were holding out well against Hampshire up to 3-3 only to see the last 4 sets disappear in Hampshire's favour. A good two wins for Amy Blagbrough fresh from the Junior National Cup. Another 2 from Martin Matuzevicus. Martin beat Andreas 3-1 and all 4 games were 11-9.

Middlesex enjoyed a surprisingly comfortable 9-1 win over Surrey. Andreas Pusch offered the most resistance, losing -10, -7, 7, 14, -8 to Ping Ho. Andreas took the consolation set against Matthew Mann 12, 3 & 5. Sarah Menghistab beat Fei Fei in 5.

Mixed fortunes was order of the day for Surrey against Sussex. John Lee beat Josh Bennett to give Surrey a 3-1 lead. Isabelle Joubaily chalked up an excellent win against Rosemary Rainton the England No 4 veteran. From 3-1 up Surrey found themselves 3-5 down, but salvaged a draw.
